Issues that are addressed with the initiative

- To contribute to the European action for road safety.
- To experience new ways of mobilization for road safety by capitalizing the gains they could accumulate and promoting a real exchange of experiences.
- To promote and grow the establishment of wide network of road safety organisations and stakeholders by pooling resources with a view to maximise the impact of the road safety actions at local, regional and global level.
- To encourage partnerships between national and regional public and private stakeholders.
- To involve youngsters in the fight against road fatalities, using the regional youth networks and to give them the opportunity to be active players in improving road safety by providing referencebased trainings on current youth issues on road safety.
- Promote the community mobility programs for youth, students and professionals interested in road safety.
- To trigger and promote dialogue between people from different cultures, organisations, enforcement bodies, policy makers and practitioners, in relation to road safety and road users thanks to the involvement of experts and a special topic on enforcement and youth.

Activities developped

The 64 road safety films have been made over the past five years and presented exclusively on digital video. Registration of movies was valid for all the festivals of the season in 2015 produced by Laser International Foundation: Casablanca, Brussels, Mumbai and Montevideo.

They are classified by categories:

- Campaigns
- Road safety education
- Driver training
- Risk prevention in professional circles
- Innovations for road safety
- TV broadcasts
- Films for youth, by youth

The European jury is composed of experts from European outreach in road safety and communication. The jury evaluates all the films in competition to decide the winners of the competition. Each video is assessed on the basis of explicit criteria:

- Intrinsic qualities (clarity and relevance of the message to the target adaptation, quality and originality of the script, reproducibility)
- Technical qualities (sound, sound design, image editing),
- Cost / effectiveness.

The European road safety film festival is produced by the Laser International Foundation (LIFE), under the aegis of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe, European parliament, UN Road Safety Collaboration, King Philippe of Belgium. It is implemented with an organization committee composed of representatives of official partners.

Genesis

The number of people killed on the road has been slightly decreasing in many European countries for a few years. Nevertheless, this improvement remains precarious, but anyway very encouraging. It was made possible thanks to various measures that were taken to intensify road safety actions, and also to the tremendous effort that was made to heighten the general public awareness.

Reasons why you chose this initiative

When communication goes together with prevention, audio-visual communications play a major part in these awareness campaigns. Indeed, it is one of the most efficient means to act on behaviours and change the way road safety problems are perceived.

That's the reason why the Laser International Foundation organizes the 1st European road safety film festival.

Transferability and multiplier effect

Laser International Foundation offers to create national road safety film festivals in each European country. The specifications will be defined with involved organizations and governments.

The European Summer University of Laser Internaitonal Foundation (SUN of LIFE) will be the tool to disseminate the film festivals in Europe.

The SUN of LIFE aim to develop a device dissemination of capacity building, knowledge and good practices to strengthen the management capacity of public officials and professionals involved in road safety.

This program differs from existing ones and proposed in the area of road safety training on several points:

- The "universities" are not residential but are held closer to the participants, to avoid them too heavy expenses for travels, but also to take in account the socio-cultural, political and economic contexts of the regions concerned.
- The approaches of the subjects related to road safety are its complexity and its diversity; they are not limited on one point of view, such as road safety related to road infrastructure. They involve cost analysis / efficiency and multi-criteria analyzes.
- The diversity of participants is an objective, diversity of sectors, experiences, responsibilities, to promote horizontal and vertical coordination.
- Bringing experts "field" competent producing road safety actions.
- Focus on training-action highlighting the practical application of training provided.
- Use peer to peer methodology in training sessions.
- It's organized in the form of five days seminars for public actors (political, technical, academics, administrative), private sector (companies, media) and NGOs.

The speakers are road safety experts specialized in the specific fields of road safety management: politics, economics, engineering, law, communication, youth policies.
