Key activities: Riding improvement training in the safe environment of motor racing circuits and polygons for more than 1,000 motorcyclists, PR activity on the topic of safe motorcycle riding, multiplication of measures, which lead to the reduction of serious injuries of motorcyclists, evaluation of the effectiveness of safe riding training courses for motorcyclists. 

Evaluation of the activities	The project is being consistently evaluated by the public research institution - Centrum dopravního výzkumu v.v.i. (Centre for traffic research). In 2016 this research institution delivered a basic evaluation of the project and an evaluation of the training course participants' satisfaction. The Road Safety Team follows modern planning methods, multiplication and most importantly the evaluation of the effectiveness of their activities.
