### Accident prevention in another way: „Life depends on a second!” presentation series

József Pintér, an accident scene police officer, has been working for the police for 27 years. After vocational high school, He served as a motor patrol at the Budapest Police Headquarters and after 18 years of accident scene service, he will perform the duties of the Veszprém Accident Prevention Committee from April 1, 2018. His job includes holding presentations for a wide range of audiences.

At the start of the program, he found a sign labeled ACCIDENT in a police warehouse, which has now become a trademark of the performance series. Thinking further about the word „accident”, he attaches the themes of his lectures to the meaning of each letter.

So the meaning of the ACCIDENT (**BALESET** in Hungarian):

- B**iztonsági öv hiánya / lack of seat belt,
- A**lkohol /alcohol,
- L**inkség / recklessness,
- E**lőzés / overtaking,
- S**ebesség / speed,
- E**lalvás / falling asleep
- T**elefon / phone.
