The Slovenian Infrastructure Agency decided to start pilot projects and the evaluation thereof, i.e. to find proactive solutions to improve motorcyclists' safety on roads. Our focus was to find Human Factors solutions, how to communicate with motorcyclists to provide them with self-explanatory or, better said, intuitive road designs. In order to address them in such a way that they will intuitively reduce their speed and change their mode or riding. In addition, if something does happen, as all the factors are hard to control, the consequences of a fall must, to the greatest degree possible, be within the tolerance of the human body.
