




Number of tests over the months 📈







#### Average consumption by age group mg/L








#### **Survey Analysis**

- 63.90% of people with an alcohol test ≥ 0.22 mg/L decided to drive.
- 44.77% of people with an alcohol test ≥ 0.22 mg/L thought they were below the legal limit.
- 76.54% of those who thought they were below but were actually above the limit said they would drive.

#### **Demographic Analysis**

- Most at-risk age group: 18-34 years old (53.37%).
- Men dominate risk behavior: 64.88% of those who drove above the limit.
- Target group for awareness: Men aged 18-34, as they are the most likely to underestimate their level and decide to drive


These findings highlight a critical gap in alcohol awareness and self-assessment. A significant portion of drivers misjudge their alcohol levels, with young men aged 18-34 being the most at-risk group. The data proves that many individuals who believe they are below the legal limit are actually over it—and still decide to drive.

The **FlineBox** plays a crucial role in bridging this gap by providing **immediate and reliable feedback** on alcohol levels. By making alcohol testing accessible in high-risk environments, it empowers individuals to make **informed**, **responsible decisions** before getting behind the wheel.







#### Consumption by age (mg/L)




